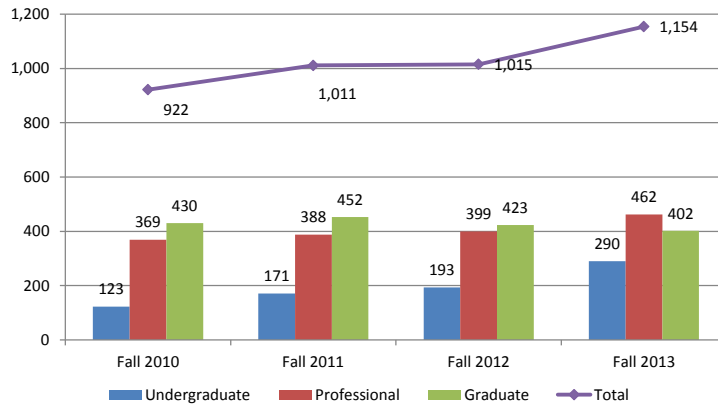
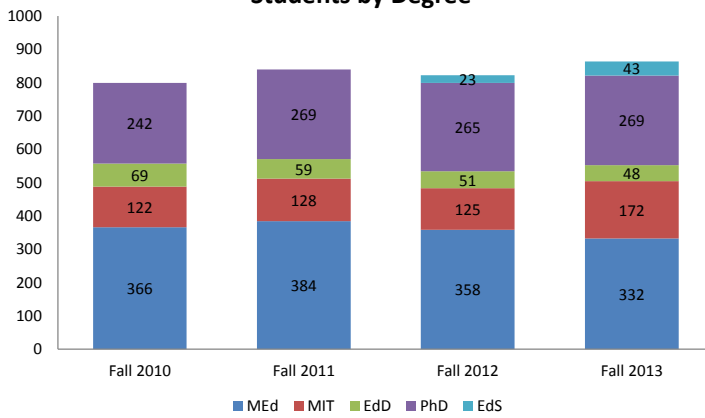

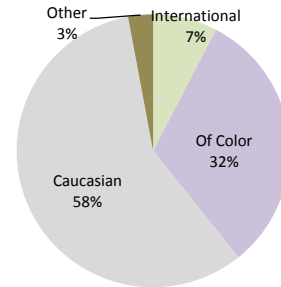
Enrolled Students by Year and Division



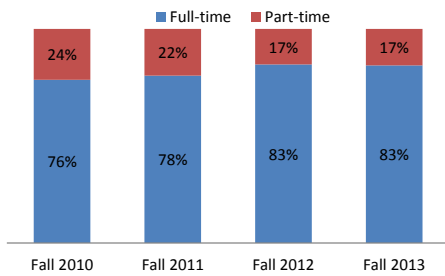
Students by Degree



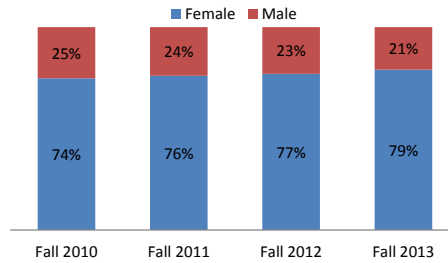
2013 Students by Ethnicity

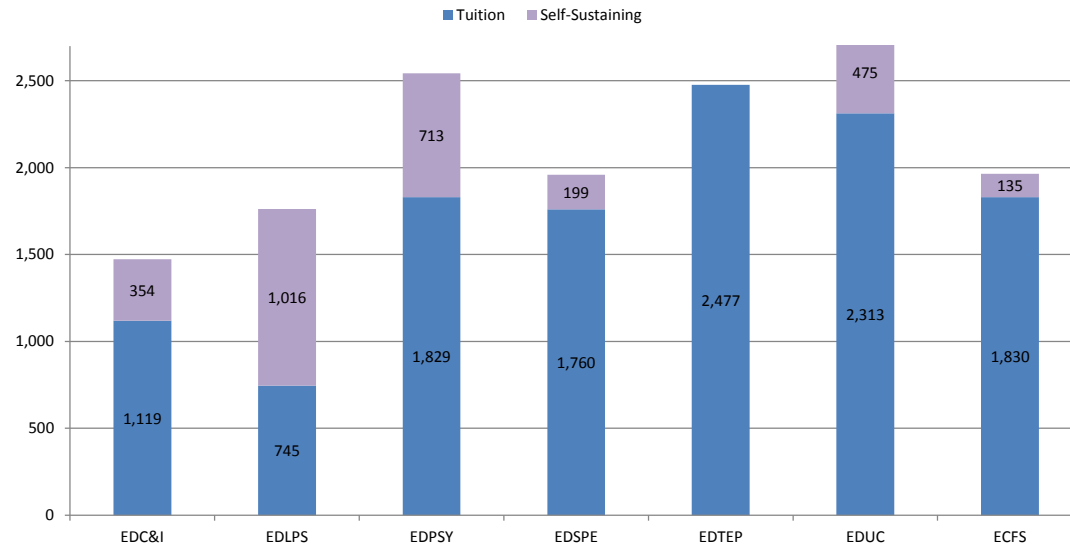
