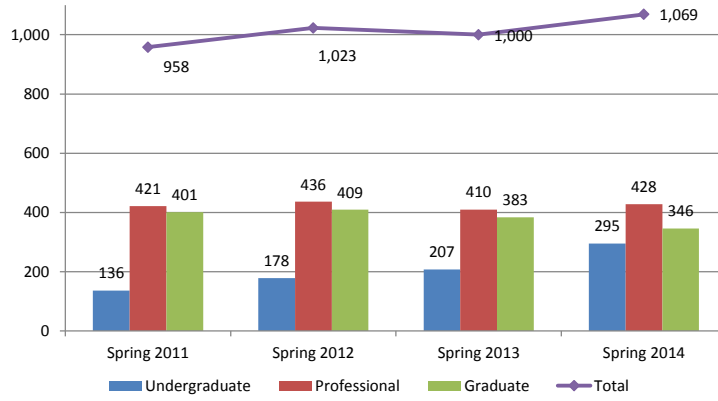
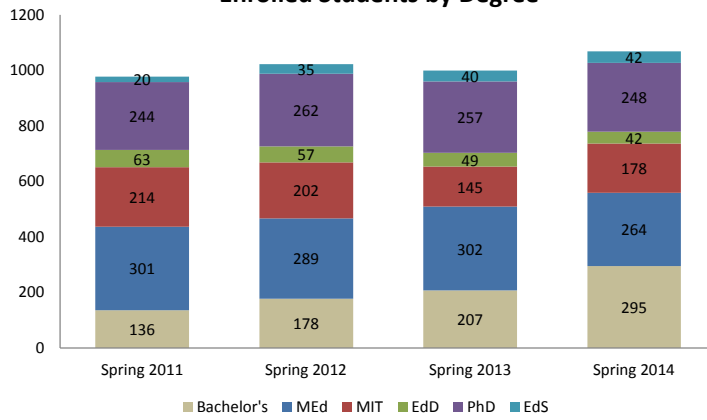

### Enrolled Students by Year and Division

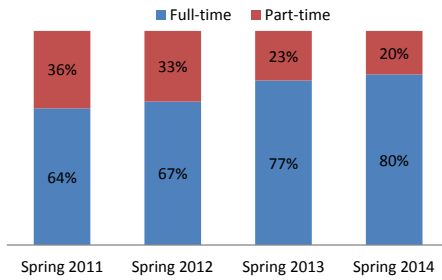


### Enrolled Students by Degree

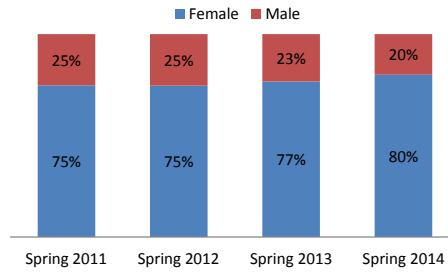

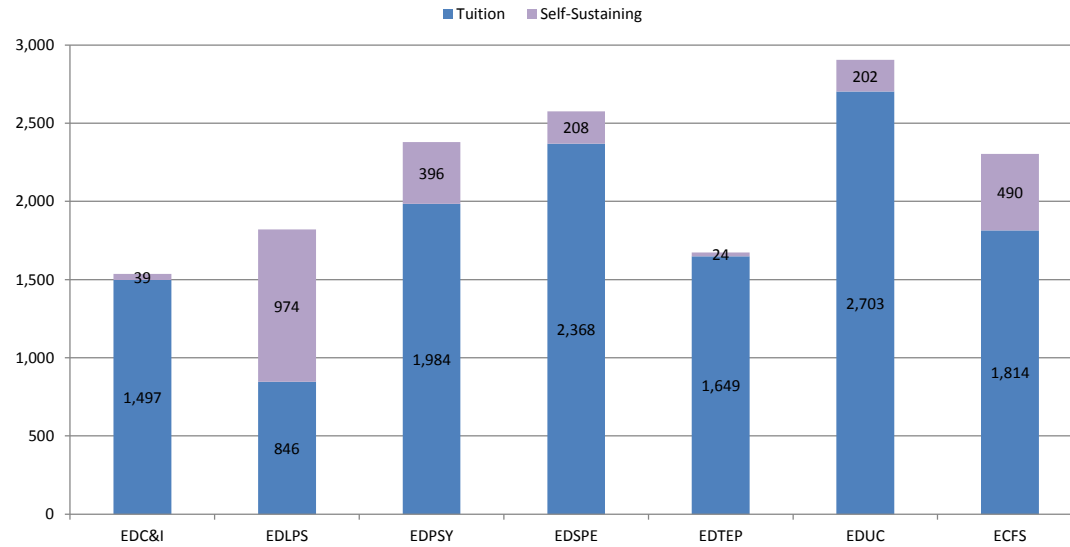
