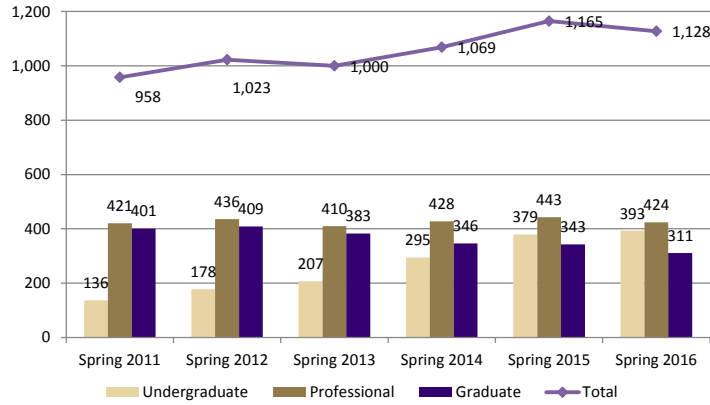
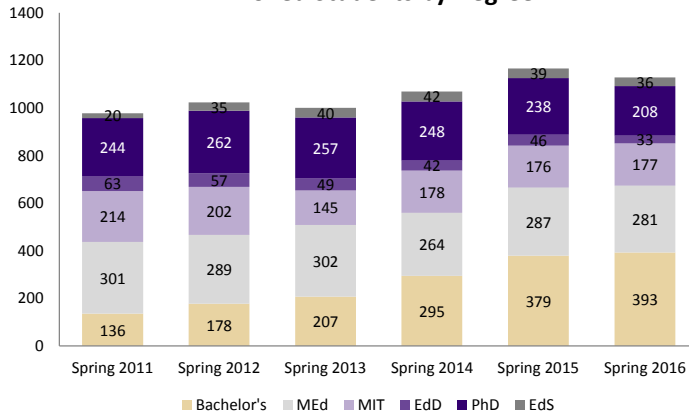

### Enrolled Students by Year and Division

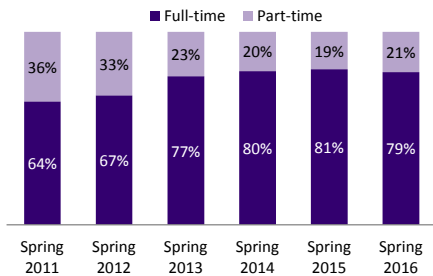


### Enrolled Students by Degree

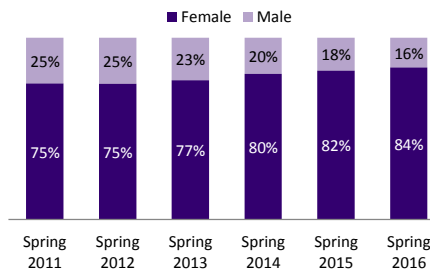

**Non-Matriculated:** number of non-matriculated students registered for classes this term, the total is including one person without a pathway code

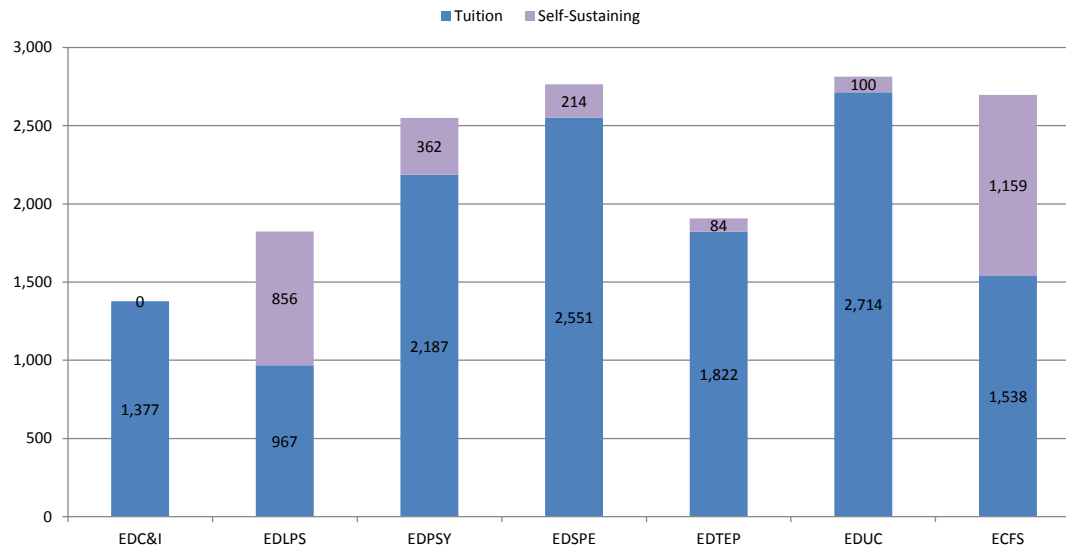
