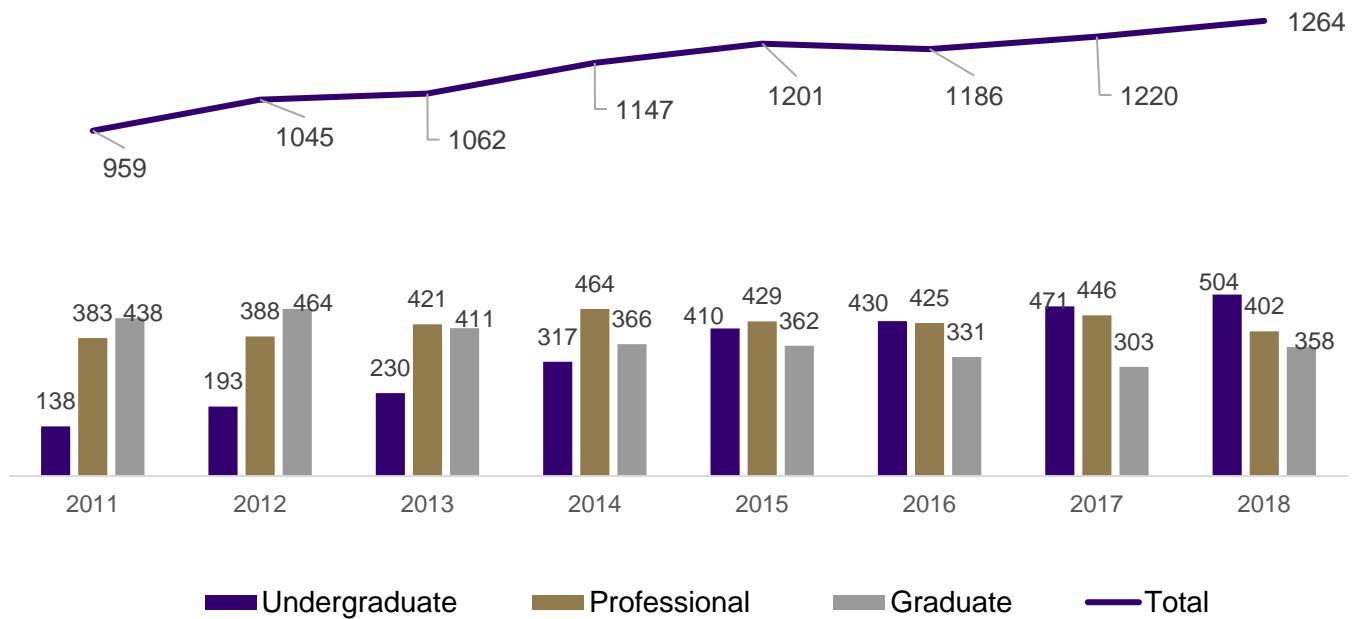

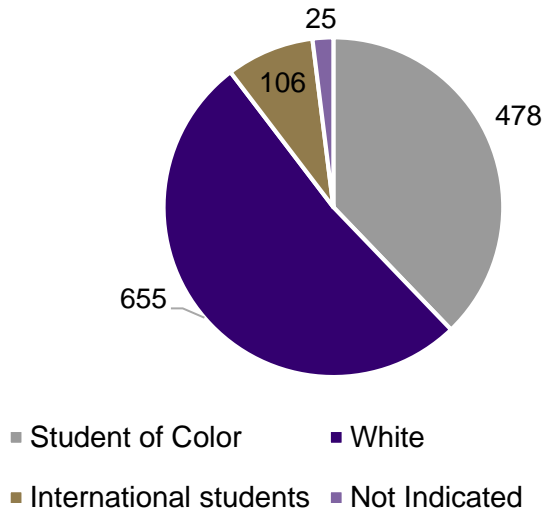
Overview

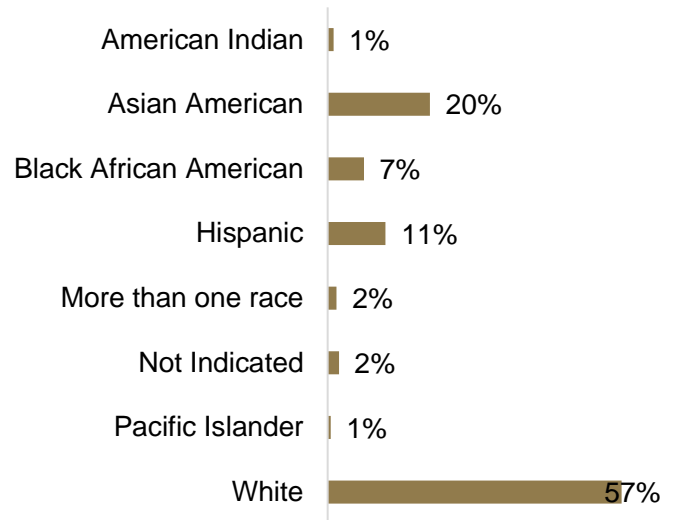
Enrolled Students by Year and Degree Type
(number of students)



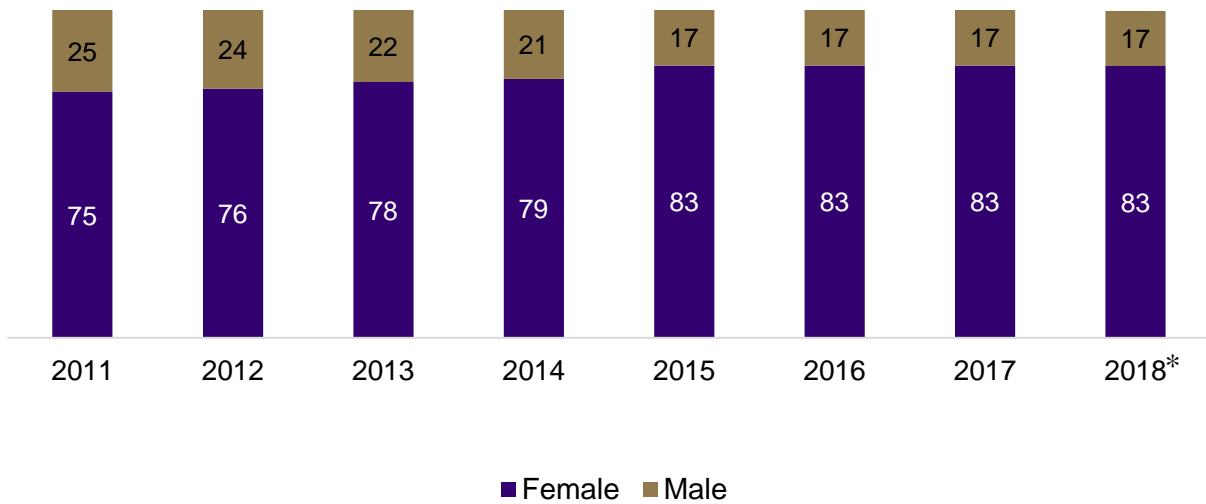
Enrollment by Race & International Status

* 4 students did not have a code for gender labeled in binary terms. This represents less than 0.05% of the total enrollment of the college and it seems not to have captured in prior years.

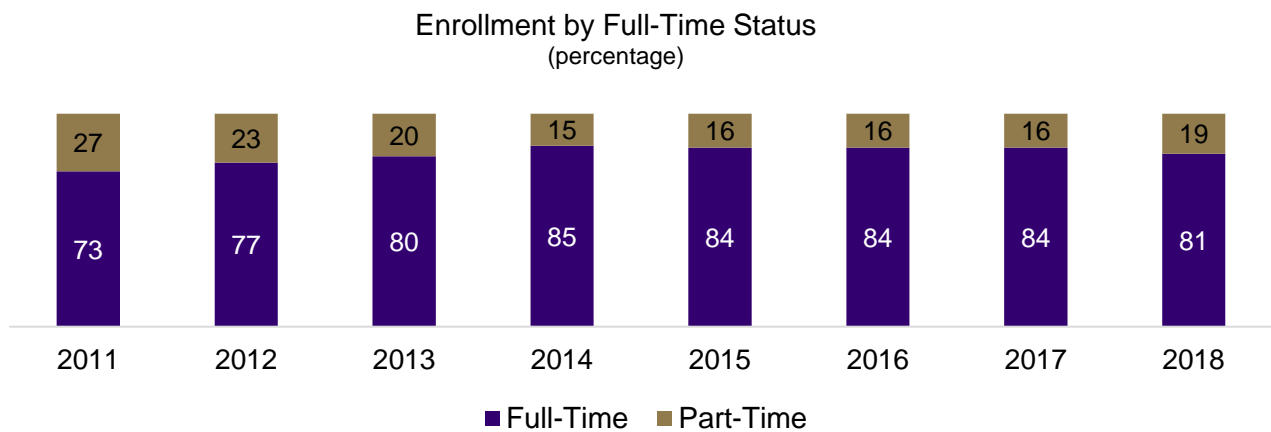
