The purpose of this report is to provide a quarterly COE fact sheet for program planning and reporting. Notes are included below each applicable table.

Highlights

- Total COE enrollment increased 3% from Autumn 2020 to Autumn 2021.
 - There was a 7% decrease for undergraduate, an 18% increase for masters, and a 1% decrease for doctorate students.
 - The greatest program growth was seen in Science Education (IW); Applied Behavioral Analysis; School Psychology PCE; and Language, Literacy, and Culture.
 - The ELS Minor increased by 38%.
- 43% of COE students are BIPOC. An additional 14% are International.
 - The number of BIPOC students has been steady over the past 4 Autumn quarters, averaging 42%.
